Reboot Kerala Hackathon 2020, organized by Additional Skill Acquisition Programme (ASAP), is an initiative to provide students of Higher Education Institutions in the state, a platform to solve some of the pressing problems we face in our daily lives, and thus inculcate a culture of product innovation and a mind-set of problem solving. Reboot Kerala Hackathon 2020 will be organized in two phases and first phase is planned as a series of 10 regional hackathons. Each hackathon will address particular problem statements identified from the corresponding ministry. The event will offer students, an opportunity to contribute to the mainstream governance by providing sustainable solutions for issues faced by various Government departments.

The contest will be a 36-hours non-stop Hardware and Software competition, in which the selected competitors will participate as a team to solve a given problem statements. A team will comprise of 6 students representing an Institution, in which at least two of them will be girls. Evaluation will be done by a panel of experts and its criteria will include novelty of the idea, complexity, clarity and details in the prescribed format, feasibility, practicability, sustainability, scale of impact, user experience and potential for future work progression. Prizes worth 1 lakh will be awarded to the winners of each hackathon.
