- Practical and theory in same semester.

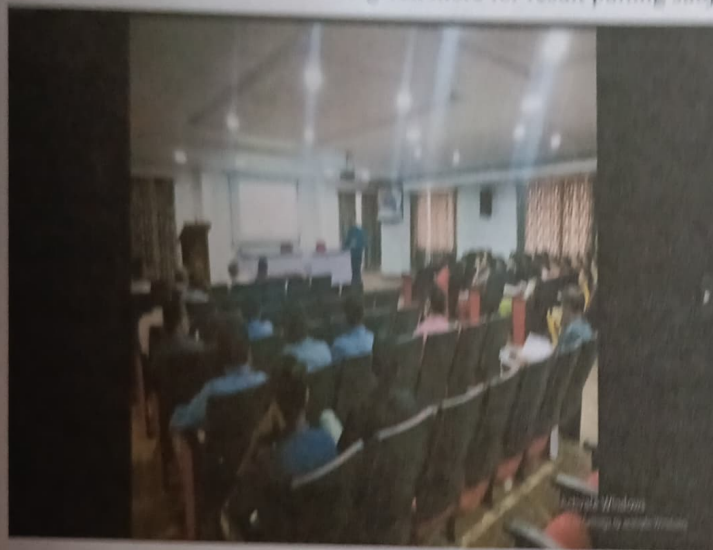
### How to improve the system
